
BOIL WATER NOTICE IN EFFECT!

- Date:** July 20, 2015
- To:** City of Wildwood Utility Customers
- Impacted Area:** All City of Wildwood Utility Customers located south of CR-472 and CR-216, west of The Villages, north of Clay Drain Road, and east of CR 219 and CR 209 (SEE MAP)
- Includes:** Lakeside Landings; Pepper Tree Apartments; Oxford Oaks; all residents along Jackson Street and the surrounding area; Wildwood Country Resort; Mission Oaks; Sumter County Service Center; Williard Peebles Industrial Park; Business Park 44; all downtown residents and businesses.
- Excludes:** Parkwood; The Villages; all residents north of CR-472 and CR-216; non-Wildwood Utility Customers
- Details:** The City of Wildwood hereby issues a **Boil Water Notice** for the impacted area described above due to a malfunctioned chorine pump at the Huey Street Water Plant. The cause of the problem and the pump has been fixed, but all residents are urged to boil water for the next 48 hours for precautionary reasons. The City anticipates lifting this Boil Water Notice after sampling confirms chlorine levels are acceptable.

****DO NOT DRINK THE WATER WITHOUT BOILING IT FIRST!! Bring all water to a boil, let it boil for at least one minute, and let it cool before using, or use bottled water. Boiled or bottled water should be used for drinking, making ice, brushing teeth, washing dishes, bathing, and food preparation until the Boil Water Notice has been lifted by the City of Wildwood****
