

**ORDINANCE NO. O2012-03**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WILDWOOD, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR THE CONTROL OF THE USE OF REMOTE CONTROL PLANES ON CITY PROPERTY EXCEPT IN AREAS DESIGNATED FOR SUCH USE BY THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Wildwood, Florida:

SECTION 1. No remote control planes may be used on City property except in areas designated as appropriate for use by the City. Any such areas will be posted with signs indicating the area where the use is allowed. In no event shall the remote control use of planes be allowed to fly over areas not specifically posted for such use.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, be, and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a Court or competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way effect the validity of the remaining portions of said ordinance.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final adoption by the City Commission.
