

RESOLUTION NO. R2012-12

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WILDWOOD, FLORIDA DETERMINING THAT CERTAIN PROPERTY IS SURPLUS; DETERMINING THE MANNER OF DISPOSAL OF SAID PROPERTY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Wildwood is the owner of certain property that was previously deemed seized and forfeited property and declared as evidence for the Police Department and,

WHEREAS, the seized and forfeited property as described can further be described as:

**One (1) 1994 GMC Pickup truck, VIN# 2GTEC19KXR1526175
Mileage – 260,200; Condition - Poor**

WHEREAS, on June 21, 2012, under case number 2012-CA-000732, Circuit Judge Hallman ruled the ownership of the vehicle to be turned over to City of Wildwood Police Department, pursuant to Sections 932.701 through 932.704, and

WHEREAS, the vehicle does not have any useful benefit to the City of Wildwood Police Department, and

WHEREAS, the vehicle can be utilized by the Sumter County Sheriff's Office, the property as identified is hereby declared surplus for reasons of disposition.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WILDWOOD, FLORIDA, THAT:

1. The vehicle identified as property is hereby declared surplus property.
2. The vehicle identified as property is to be transferred to the Sumter County Sheriff's Office.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its final adoption by the City Commission of the City of Wildwood.
