

RESOLUTION NO. R2012-24

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WILDWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO MAKE APPLICATION TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY FOR APPROVAL OF A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT IN THE **ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CATEGORY (CDBG-ED)** SPONSORED BY THE CITY OF WILDWOOD; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS there is a need for greater employment opportunities in the City of Wildwood, and

WHEREAS it is the desire of the City Commission to help increase employment opportunities for local residents, particularly those with low to moderate incomes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF WILDWOOD, FLORIDA;

SECTION 1. That the Community Development Block Grant, Economic Development (CDBG-ED) program is declared to be a workable program for assisting with the creation of new jobs for low-to-moderate income persons.

SECTION 2. The City Commission hereby directs the Mayor, Mayor Pro Tem, City Manager or City Clerk, in his/her absence, to sign all necessary certifications of the Community Development Block Grant application, grant contract or other grant documents required by the CDBG-ED program.

SECTION 3. That the City Commission directs the Mayor, Mayor Pro Tem, City Manager or City Clerk, in his/her absence, to execute and submit the FFY 2012 CDBG-ED grant application to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity for state approval.

SECTION 4. That the Mayor, Mayor Pro Tem, City Manager or City Clerk, in his/her absence, is authorized and directed to submit additional information in a timely manner as may be required by Florida Department of Economic Opportunity during the application review process and after execution of a contract agreement with the Department.

SECTION 5. The proposed CDBG-ED application is consistent with the local comprehensive plan.

SECTION 6. The City's comprehensive plan is adopted as the City's community development plan.


SECTION 7. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.


