

RESOLUTION NO. R2014-27

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WILDWOOD, FLORIDA, PLACING A MORATORIUM ON THE PERMITTING OF NEW BINGO HALLS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Commission finds that there is the increased potential for the commission of crimes or violations of the Florida Statutes related to bingo halls;

WHEREAS, the Commission finds that the present provisions in the Florida Statutes are inadequate to fully achieve regulation of bingo halls;

WHEREAS, the Commission desires to ensure that no laws are broken, and to protect the public's health, safety and welfare, the City is willing to place a moratorium on permitting new bingo halls within the City until the City has adopted an ordinance regulating bingo halls and providing for sufficient security measures;

WHEREAS, the Commission moved to pass a moratorium at the regularly scheduled City Commission hearing on June 9, 2014.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WILDWOOD, FLORIDA, THAT:

1. A moratorium is hereby placed on permitting of new bingo halls in the City of Wildwood.
2. This Resolution shall be in effect as of June 10, 2014 and shall remain in effect until the City Commission passes an ordinance concerning the allowance and regulation of bingo halls.
