

RESOLUTION NO. R2015-37

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WILDWOOD, FLORIDA, PLACING A MORATORIUM ON PERMITTING BILLBOARDS IN THE CITY OF WILDWOOD; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Wildwood adopted Ordinance 595 establishing requirements and standards for new billboards erected in the City of Wildwood on February 11, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wildwood has determined that because the language contained in Ordinance 595 is ambiguous, the City is willing to place a moratorium on permitting new billboards within the City until the Ordinance can be considered and revised; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WILDWOOD, FLORIDA, THAT:

1. A moratorium is hereby placed on the issuance of any permits or approvals for any Billboards in the City of Wildwood, including those under consideration for approval.
2. This moratorium shall not affect any existing billboard for which a permit has already been issued by the City.
3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Commission of the City of Wildwood, Florida, and shall remain in place until further action of the City Commission..
