City of Wildwood Announces New Traffic Pattern at Gamble and Hall
Changes Take Place Wednesday, October 26, 2022

Wildwood officials are alerting residents and visitors to a traffic pattern change taking place Wednesday at the intersection of South Gamble and Hall streets.

“We are converting the intersection from a four-way stop to a two-way stop in compliance with recommendations by the National Cooperative of Highway Research Programs,” Public Works Director Jeremy Hockenbury said. “Motorists, bicyclists, and pedestrians should be aware that traffic on Hall Street will no longer stop before crossing South Gamble Street.”

The adjustment is being implemented after consultation with transportation engineers at Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc., who performed traffic counts as part of a study and analysis of the intersection.

Variable message signs to notify the public have been located along approaches to the crossing and will remain in place for two weeks.
