Vacant Homes located in the City shall be maintained and kept secure, landscaping of vacant buildings must also be maintained at all times.

A vacant house is not a violation of any City code and cannot be addressed by Code Enforcement.

However, if a home is vacant, open and accessible and is also being accessed by unauthorized persons, Code Enforcement can respond and ensure that the property is secured. Contact the Police Department if you see any illegal activity.





Property maintenance whether vacant or occupied must be maintained at all times. Please keep all play areas, gardens, flower beds, unpaved driveways, walkways, and the like, free of vegetative cover and should be clearly defined and maintained free of uncultivated growth.
