

GRASS HEIGHT

Do you know about the City of Wildwood rules on Grass Height?

RESIDENTIAL/COMMERCIAL: Grass, bushes, plants, and weeds may not grow to such a height that they constitute a hazard by promoting the presence of pests, rodents, snakes, or other animals; camouflage the existence of litter, glass or other materials that might constitute a safety hazard; and/or create an unsightly appearance. This applies to all residential homes and commercial properties (vacant or occupied).

Grass height is not regulated for undeveloped properties.

After sending a Notice of Violation to the owner, the City of Wildwood may have the owner appear before the special magistrate if compliance is not met.

Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is responsible for cutting tall grass along roads or in medians on state-maintained roads
