Litter can reduce property values, hurt the health of our neighborhoods and is a result of an individuals behavior—choosing to be careless in the handling of waste.

Approved Garbage Containers: Place secured/tied bags inside the trash container. Do not overfill the container.

Place trash container on the curbside on your collection day or the evening before.

Bring all trash containers away from the curb once emptied.

Clean trash containers regularly.

Easy tips for preventing litter: Keep a litter bag in your car and hang on to the bag until you find a garbage container. Make sure your garbage container has tight fitting lids.

Prevention Ideas Keep the front and side areas of your property and the Right-of-Way clear of all litter and debris. Share with others on the proper way to dispose of trash.

Encourage your neighbors to join you in an area cleanup.
