RENT ONE OF OUR FACILITIES

All rentals require a refundable damage deposit at the time of booking to ensure your space is reserved.

The balance for a reservation is due 14 days prior to your event and must be paid in full before your event takes place. Please note, all rentals require you to clean up before leaving the property; this includes sweeping, mopping (if necessary for spills and residue), taking out the trash, and putting away all tables and chairs.

We book rentals/parties very far in advance and your date may not be available!

Please come with multiple dates in mind. We may not be able to accommodate any last-minute rentals within a two-week period depending on the location.

Reservations that are canceled with less than a 48-hour notice will receive a refund for the rental but forfeit the cost of the deposit.

You may apply for an alcohol permit for your event no less than 30 days in advance. The fee for a Wildwood Police officer is \$50/hour and must be paid in cash to the officer at the beginning of your rental.

If you need assistance with setting up tables and chairs for your rental, an additional fee will be applied to your rental for our staff to setup and breakdown for you, if staffing is available.







THE HISTORIC BAKER HOUSE

COME TAKE A TRIP THROUGH HISTORY BACK TO 1890...

The Historic Baker House, built by Senator David Hume Baker in the community of Orange Home, is now a historic landmark in Wildwood, Florida.

David Hume Baker, his wife Mary, and son David Matthis relocated here from their native Kentucky home in 1886. He became one of the most successful citrus growers in the area!





David Hume Baker was elected to the Florida House of Representatives in 1897 and the Senate in 1899 for several terms. The Senator passed away in 1917 and was laid to rest, along with his wife, in Arlington Cemetery.

Many more details of his life, the Baker family, and this beautiful home are revealed during our house tours!

While you're here, come and:

<u>Explore</u> this exquisite 1890's home restored to its original splendor as one of the finest homes in the area. <u>Learn</u> about the five generations of Bakers who inhabited the home. <u>Enter</u> this time capsule of another era by attending one of our special events!

Come introduce yourself and let us know how we can work together for events, programs, and community outreach.




