OXFORD WATER TREATMENT PLANT ONLINE

- Details:** The City of Wildwood hereby issues the following public notice concerning the Oxford Water Treatment Plant. The construction of the new water treatment plant is nearing completion, and the City plans to bring this new water plant online on March 30, 2020. This new plant is needed to meet the needs of our growing community.

As the startup process evolves it is possible that some residual of Hydrogen Sulfide could remain in the water. Hydrogen Sulfide is unpleasant to smell, but it is harmless at the levels our customers may experience. This inconvenience will be temporary and will cease once the City has made the necessary adjustments to the biological treatment processes that are necessary to fully mitigate the hydrogen sulfide.

The City wants to assure its customers that the water is safe for consumption and use. The City remains committed to providing high quality drinking water to its customers. Rest assured City staff will work diligently and quickly to address any issues that may arise during this transition to the new water plant.
