

RESOLUTION NO. R2014-36

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WILDWOOD, FLORIDA DETERMINING THAT CERTAIN PROPERTY IS SURPLUS; DETERMINING THE MANNER OF DISPOSAL OF SAID PROPERTY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Wildwood is the owner of certain property that was previously deemed seized and forfeited property and declared as evidence for the Police Department and,

WHEREAS, the seized and forfeited property as described can further be described as:

**One (1) 1996 Chevrolet S10, pickup truck,
VIN# 1GCCS14X5T8103909
Condition - Fair to Poor**

WHEREAS, the vehicle's owner abandoned the property and thus ownership of the vehicle was turned over to the City of Wildwood Police Department, pursuant to Florida Statutes Chapter 932, and

WHEREAS, the vehicle does not have any useful benefit to the City of Wildwood Police Department, and

WHEREAS, the vehicle can be utilized by the Sumter County Sheriff's Office, the property as identified is hereby declared surplus for reasons of disposition.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WILDWOOD, FLORIDA, THAT:

1. The vehicle identified as property is hereby declared surplus property.
2. The vehicle identified as property is to be transferred to the Sumter County Sheriff's Office.


This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its final adoption by the City Commission of the City of Wildwood.
