FFY 2015 CDBG LOCAL MATCH RESOLUTION
RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
CITY OF WILDWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING CITY
FUNDS AND THE VALUE LAND THAT WILL BE OWNED
BY THE CITY OF WILDWOOD TO BE USED AS LOCAL
MATCH FOR THE PROPOSED FFY 2015 COMMUNITY
DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT, NEIGHBORHOOD
REVITALIZATION GRANT APPLICATION; PROVIDING
FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Wildwood, Florida plans to provide improvements to the community to benefit low and moderate income persons; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wildwood will apply for Federal Fiscal Year 2015 grant funds in the Neighborhood Revitalization Category of the Florida Small Cities Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program to fund community improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enhance the planned CDBG improvements by contributing local funds in the amount of \$25,000 to the project, which will serve as local match to the CDBG funds; and,

WHEREAS, the City desires to further enhance the project by contributing the value of land that it owns to the project. The land, which is valued at \$14,700, is currently vacant, will be used for the construction of a drainage retention area, and is subject to a purchase agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WILDWOOD, FLORIDA;

SECTION 1. The City shall combine local funds in the amount of \$25,000 with the anticipated \$700,000 CDBG Neighborhood Revitalization grant. The local funds will be used for repaving activities as described in the CDBG grant application.

SECTION 2. The City shall contribute the value of land that it will own to the CDBG project in the amount of \$14,700. The land will be used for the construction of a drainage retention area in the Sunset Park area.

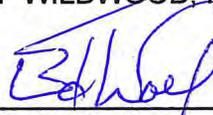
SECTION 3. The local funds and the value of land will be used to claim points in the CDBG grant application. The funds will be expended after the date of the grant agency's Site Visit and before administrative closeout of the CDBG grant.

SECTION 4. That the Mayor, Vice Mayor, City Manager, City Clerk, or designee in his/her absence, is authorized and directed to execute any document, paperwork, or other required authorization to otherwise implement this resolution in a timely manner as may be required by the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity during the application review process and after execution of a contract agreement with the Department.

SECTION 5. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

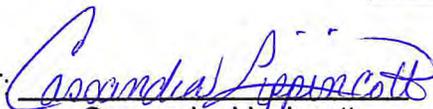

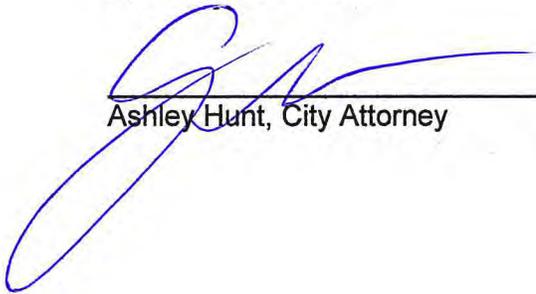
